Protective Behaviours (PBs)

Protective Behaviours (PBs) is a practical and down to earth approach to personal safety with an emphasis on prevention. PBs help children (and adults) focus on feeling safe, choices, self protection, taking responsibility and accessing appropriate support and particularly promoting the role of a friend in disclosing issues of abuse.

It is a process which encourages self-empowerment and brings with it the skills to avoid being victimised.

This is achieved by helping young people recognise and trust their intuitive feelings (early warning signs) and it develops strategies for self-protection.

Protective Behaviours is beneficial in a range of circumstances including:

- ★ Bullying
- ★ Racism, sexism, ageism
- ★ Harassment
- ★ Conflict resolution
- ★ Abuse of all kinds
- ★ Helping people realise they have choices
- ★ Restorative justice
- ★ Mentoring
- ★ Healthy schools

Purpose of training

The training will explore key principles in the Protective behaviours process and the relevance to young people of all ages and abilities including self.
