- *Learning from Taize's model of worship and reflection with young people*

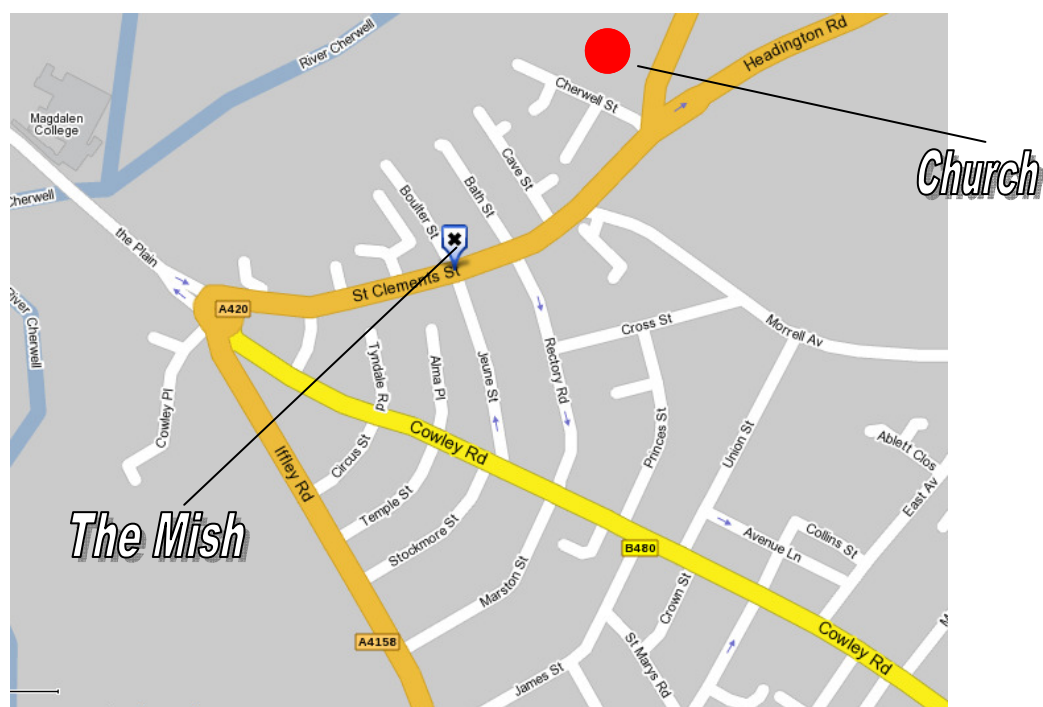
The event will run from 1pm—4pm at 'the Mish' which is on St Clements in Oxford (see over)

(01865 248276) in Oxford (best found by looking for where the 'London Tube' stops outside St Andrews bookshop and then going around the back of the shop where you'll find the entrance.

The Mish has no car parking as such but it is possible to park your car at St Clements church and then walk 200yds or so. Or take the Park n ride by parking at Thornhill and catching the bus which runs and often and stops by the park just before St Clements.
